Amadigi di Gaula (HWV 11) is a "magic" opera in three acts, with music by George Frideric Handel. It was the fifth Italian opera that Handel wrote for London and was composed during his stay at Burlington House in 1715. It is based on Amadis de Grèce, a French tragédie-lyrique by André Cardinal Destouches and Antoine Houdar de la Motte.

The librettist for Amadigi di Gaula is not identified in the word book produced to accompany the first performances, but as it is based on an original French source some believe that it is the work of Nicolas Haym, who had adapted Teseo for Handel in 1713.

Amadigi di Gaula (HWV 11) is a rarely performed early opera by Handel, composed in 1715 while he was staying at Burlington House (pictured), the London home of the young Earl of Burlington, Richard Boyle. It is now, in altered form, the home of the Royal Academy. Boyle had inherited the house and adjoining estate aged 10.

When Amadigi di Gaula was composed, Protestant King George I of Great Britain had been on the throne for about a year, chosen instead of many potential Catholic heirs who had been considered to succeed Queen Anne. Handel, born in Germany like the new king, had already been working for the king since 1710 as his Kapellmeister.

Alternative Title: "Amadis de Gaula" Amadís of Gaul, Spanish Amadís De Gaula, prose romance of chivalry, possibly Portuguese in origin. The first known version of this work, dating from 1508, was written in Spanish by Garci Ordóñez (or Rodríguez) de Montalvo, who claimed to have "corrected and emended" corrupt originals.

Handel reused a good deal of the music of Sillain his next opera Amadigi di Gaula, produced at the King's Theatre on 25 May 1715. The libretto, probably by Nicola Haym, was based on a French model, originally set by André Destouches in 1699.
