You will see that nothing is introduced that is not contained in the text of the lesson, and will thus learn how rich is the Word of God. . . . "Life in the world to come will be very real. How sad it is that so many know of no joy except in imagination, and find no happiness except in dreams. But the real- that which God creates- is infinitely beyond the wildest flights of human imagination. Imagination is not needed by the servants of God, for the real brings to them wonders of joy and happiness and knowledge that have never been conceived of by any human heart. There will be nothing vague or misty or shadowy in the new earth, but people will associate together just as in this world, only with no trace of sin. It is sin that has made this earth what it is, and all the change that is needed to make it new is to remove sin from it. 'They shall build houses, and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and eat of the fruit of them.' There will be possessions in the land, but no buying and selling, for everything will be free as the gift of God. 'All mine is thine' will be the motto of every inhabitant. That which socialists vainly dream of, and infinitely more, is assured to men through the Gospel."
